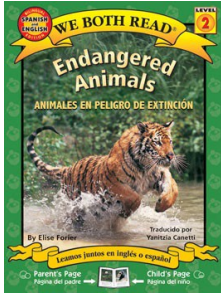


Storytime Ideas



Book Title: Endangered Animals/Animales En Peligro

About the Book: This book looks at why some animals are in danger of becoming extinct and describes some of the positive steps being taken to protect them.

Storytime Activities:

Dress Up Fun!

Use animal hats, mask, or makeup and make different animal sounds!

What's in the Mystery Bag?

Print out pictures of endangered animals and animals that are pets. Pull out each picture and have the children name the animal. You can use this time to talk about "endangered animals."

Whiteboard Activities:

Make two columns listed endangered and household animals. Share the pictures of the animals and tape the animal under the correct column title and share why it is endangered or a household animal.

Actions & Transitions:

- **Before Reading:**
 - Look at the cover. Ask: What animal do you see on the cover? What do you know about Tigers?
- **During Reading:**
 - As you read the story, point out, and discuss the bold words to help familiarize the children with the words and help to build their vocabulary.
- **After Reading:**
 - Check for understanding: Ask: What does endangered animals mean? Can you name an endangered animal? What can you do to help save endangered animals?
